

Driving Directions (As of 4/8/08)

The Boulevard of the Allies Bridge carrying the Boulevard over Forbes Ave. is currently closed for replacement and detours are in effect. For updated information, visit www.penn.dot.com or www.otma-pgh.org/project_sr885/default.aspx.

From Points East via I-76 and I-376

Traveling from the east via the PA Turnpike (I-76) take Exit 57 (old exit 6) to I-376 West toward Pittsburgh. From I-376, take Exit 3B Oakland (old exit 7A). At the end of the ramp, turn right onto Bates St. Travel on Bates St. through one light (first intersection) until it ends at Bouquet St. Turn left onto Bouquet, then right at the first light onto Forbes Ave. Forbes Ave. leads into the Pitt campus. See *Reaching Parking*.*

From Points West/North via I-76, I-79, and I-279

Traveling from the west via the PA Turnpike (I-76) take Exit 28 (Cranberry-old exit 3) and follow I-79 South to I-279 South. (You exit to the left off I-79.) Follow I-279 into the city to the I-376/Monroeville Exit. Forbes Avenue leads into the Pitt campus. See *Reaching Parking*.*

From Points North via I-279, Routes 28 and 65

Follow signs from I-279, Route 28 or Route 65 to the Parkway East (I-376) East Bound via the Fort Duquesne Bridge toward Monroeville. Once on the Parkway East, take the Forbes Ave./Oakland Exit. Forbes Ave. leads into the Pitt campus. See *Reaching Parking*.*

From Points West/Airport via the Fort Pitt Bridge

Travel through the Fort Pitt Tunnel and across the Fort Pitt Bridge and onto the Parkway East (I-376) toward Monroeville. Once on the Parkway East, take the Forbes Ave./Oakland Exit. Forbes Ave. leads into the Pitt campus. See *Reaching Parking*.*

From Boulevard of the Allies (from Downtown)

This route is not recommended due to PennDot construction projects. If you find yourself on the Boulevard heading East, you will be directed onto the Parkway East (I-376) through the Squirrel Hill Tunnels to the Swissvale Exit onto Monongahela Ave. to Braddock Ave. and back onto the Parkway East (I-376) west bound toward Pittsburgh. From I-376, take Exit 3B Oakland (old exit 7A). At the end of the ramp, turn right onto Bates St. Travel on Bates St. through one light (first intersection) until it ends at Bouquet St. Turn left onto Bouquet, then right at the first light onto Forbes Ave. Forbes Ave. leads into the Pitt campus. See *Reaching Parking*.*

From Points South

Traveling from the south via SR 51 and West Liberty Ave., take the Liberty Bridge to Forbes Ave. Do not take the Boulevard of the Allies Exit as construction prevents direct access into Oakland. Forbes Ave. leads into the Pitt campus. See *Reaching Parking*.*

*Reaching Parking

Parking at the Museum of Natural History from Forbes Avenue

Take Forbes Avenue past Schenley Plaza and turn right at the light at S. Craig St. into the Museum's parking lot.

Parking at Soldiers and Sailors Garage from Forbes Avenue

Take Forbes Ave. past Schenley Plaza and turn left at the light at S. Bellefield Ave. (directly across from the Carnegie Museum). Turn left onto Fifth Ave. and make the fourth right onto Bellefield Ave. Turn left into the parking garage.

Public Transportation

Bus Service

Port Authority of Allegheny County operates the mass transit system serving metropolitan Pittsburgh. Bus service to the Oakland area is frequent; local buses numbered 71 (1, B, C, or D), 67 (A or F), or 61 (A, B, or C) come into Oakland and may be boarded along Fifth Avenue in Downtown Pittsburgh. For bus routes and times call 412-442-2000.

Cab Service

Yellow Cab (412-665-8100) and People's Cab (412-441-3200) provide service to the Oakland area. Fares from Downtown are approximately \$7, and fares from the airport are approximately \$30.

Parking

Convenient, paid parking is available in several garages surrounding the Festival site. Parking in Oakland is generally available at this time of year as the University is on summer break.

Carnegie Museum Parking Lot

Intersection of Forbes Ave. and S. Craig St. Clearance is 6' 8", with upper deck parking for larger vehicles (full-sized vans, campers, etc.).

Metered Parking

Metered parking (50¢ per hour – 2 hr or 4 hr maximum) is available on several streets in the area. Metered Kiosk Parking is available near the Carnegie Library. Machines accept credit cards and cash, but do not give change (\$1 per hour for the first 4, and then \$2 per hour after that).

Bus Drop Off and Parking

The Bus Drop Off point will be located on Forbes Avenue along Schenley Plaza, just past Clemente Drive. Complimentary bus parking will be provided for groups. Group leaders will receive bus parking information with their ticket order.
